HARVEST FESTIVAL THURSDAY 17TH **OCTOBER**



Once again, for our Harvest Festival we are going to support the Loaves and Fishes Food Bank, which is run from St John's Church Hall in Sevenoaks. This charity supports local families by providing them with non-perishable food items each week. It is currently supporting 40 families across the district with the help of local churches of all denominations and Sainsbury's supermarket. The families receive a bag of food every week of the year.

We would greatly appreciate donations of the following food items listed below. Those in bold are urgently required. Please note they do not require pasta as they currently have large supplies of this. Tinned vegetables (preferably peas/carrots/green beans/sweetcorn). Tinned meat for hot meals (eg. minced beef & onion, stew/casserole, chicken in white sauce). Tinned fruit. UHT milk, Fruit juice (long-life)/fruit squash, Rice, Sauces for rice dishes: curry/Sweet & Sour, Tomato ketchup/brown sauce/mayonnaise, Fray Bentos pies, Tinned ravioli, Tinned macaroni cheese, Tinned hot dogs, Spaghetti/baked beans with sausages, Tinned meat for cold meals (eg ham, luncheon meat, corned beef), Custard (tins or cartons, but not custard powder), Rice pudding (tinned), Coffee/hot chocolate, Sugar, Honey/jam/marmalade.

Please send in any donations you have with your child on Thursday 17th October. If there are any parents who are able to help take the food to the food bank on Thursday 17th October from 1pm please let the school office know. Thank you for your anticipated support.
