On Wednesday 12 February (7:30pm), as part of our Focus on Online Safety Week, we are delighted to be hosting a talk Play virtual, live real: keeping your children safe online from The Breck Foundation which was set up in 2014 in response to the tragic murder of Breck Bednar, a 14-year-old Surrey schoolboy who loved science, computing and gaming

Admission to the event is free and will be hosted in our Pamoja Hall, The Space. Please do pass this onto your staff and parents who are welcome to attend.

'Breck was an 'A' grade student from a loving family and no one would have expected Breck to be a victim of grooming. His mother Lorin, who set up the foundation, believes that he would still be alive today if he had heard a talk like this. We are absolutely thrilled that Lorin herself is coming to speak and to give advice on staying safe online and we urge you not to miss this amazing opportunity to make a real difference to your knowledge and understanding of online risks and hence all our children's safety.'

The talk will start at 7.30pm in the Pamoja Hall, Sevenoaks School, with a Q&A at the end.

Assisted Instrument Purchase Scheme (AIPS)

The assisted instrument purchase scheme enables the purchase of musical instruments for children through their school **net of VAT** providing certain criteria are met. Children must be receiving tuition at school and the instrument must be used as part of the tuition. The instrument must be appropriate to the pupil's needs.

If you are considering purchasing an instrument for your child to use during their music tuition in school, please do discuss with your music teacher or Mrs Wicks in the School Office. If the conditions are met, we will happily arrange for the purchase to be made through the AIPS.

Parents must pay the cost price net of VAT in full prior to taking delivery of the instrument.


