There were some incredible victories and a few hard fought draws; resilience and determination was shown by all 24 Amherst players.

The U11A team- Tessa, Violet, Aoife, Noah, James and Lucas- came 3rd out of 12 teams on 15.5/25 points. The U11B team- Harry, George, Benjamin, Ryan, Nicholas
