Feedback on the new style lunchtime is that it is calmer, quieter and the children enjoy sitting as a class. The zones outside for playtime and lunchtime have also been positively received. The children have more space utilising half the field and half the playground for one year group at a time.

I have been so impressed with the children's positive attitude and how quickly they have settled into the new routines.

A special mention to our new Year 3 children and other new children who have made a super start to their time at Amherst. The Year 3 teaching team have

all commented how well they have adapted and managed the transition process successfully.


