Message from Mr Reid

The children have continued to enjoy being back at school, even if a little tired at times. We are all gaining our school resilience back after such a long period away.

This week I started **reading a book** with my children at home called 'Dare to be You' by Matthew Syed. It is an excellent book that I would recommend which contains valuable advice and guidance to children (and adults!) as they develop. It is written in a style that is engaging and accessible across a range of ages.

The book focuses on the ability to defy self-doubt, follow your own path and be confidently you. It is written post lockdown and contains some very timely messages. Key points that it helps children work towards are:

- Make friends with people who like you for you.
- Make choices based on what you feel is right.
- Don't blindly copy other people. Be you.
- Ask questions. Keep asking questions. Make things work for you.
- Don't be afraid to do things at your own pace.
- You should be prepared to be flexible.
- Be kind. And don't listen to anyone who isn't kind towards you.
- Make it happen. Don't wait. Get out there. It is down to you.
- Dare to be different. Dare to be you.

Below is an extract from the book to give you a feel for the style of writing.




