
Shackleton's Journey

There has been a buzz of excitement and learning this week

as we launched this term's whole school book project. This time we will be studying Shackleton's Journey by William Grill.

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For new parents to our school (and some old!) we complete a whole school book project twice a year in November and March. What is unique about these projects is that the whole school studies the same text at the same time. A simple original Amherst idea that has been highly successful. The project lasts for approx. three weeks and generates amazing outcomes in writing and art. Incredible displays are then produced for the hall, surrounding corridors and classrooms to celebrate the children's achievements.

The projects are an opportunity for each year group to have complete freedom over the writing and art that is produced based on the book selected. I find the next three weeks are some of the most exciting and productive weeks of the

school year. One of my favourite moments is when the displays begin to go up and each year groups' work is revealed.

So pleased don't be surprised if your child is suddenly very interested in Antarctica! Shackleton's Journey is a wonderful book and I would recommend buying a copy for home if you have not already done so.

This term's school value is Kindness.

When questioned the children always place Kindness as their most important value and I agree with them.

Applying for primary schools.

An impact of COVID has been that **less people have moved to Sevenoaks** this year from abroad and within the UK. This has resulted for the first time that Amherst is not full in Year 3.

It made me reflect that many families outside of Riverhead are not aware that any **child** can join Amherst at the beginning of Year 3 through the normal admissions process. We have **96 spaces in Year 3** and only 90 children transfer from Riverhead. This means every year there are 6 spaces for new children.

I may be biased but I believe many parents would jump at the chance for their child to attend Amherst for Years 3-6 but are not aware it is an option. Why would you not want to come to Amherst!

Applications for September 2021 open on Thursday 5 November 2020 and close at midnight on Friday 15 January 2021. If you are a current Year 2 parent at Riverhead you will need to apply through KCC.

Please help promote locally joining Amherst in Year 3 as I anticipate we may have the same dynamic next year with less movement internationally and within the UK. Not being full (384 pupils) has a financial implication for the school as we are funded per pupil.

You as current parents are the most powerful form of recommendation to a prospective parent. As I always do, I am completing individual meetings (via Zoom this year) with prospective parents. - Step 3: Complete any required Supplementary Information Forms (SIF) and/or medical evidence and return to the school.
- Step 4: We offer you a place on National Offer Day.
- Step 5: You accept or refuse the place and provide your proof of address from the application period to the school.
- Step 6: If you don't get a place at your preferred school you can join the waiting list and appeal.
