We have been considering for some time how we can enhance children's playtimes and lunchtimes at Amherst. In the past we have explored options such as a new adventure play structure. Since returning to school the children have been amazing but I am aware that playtimes and lunchtimes are somewhat restricted due to the zones. They used to have full access of the site but now each year group has a designated area.

Whilst I was on a run last weekend I was considering how to improve playtimes for all children and what is it they really want. The answer then became clear - toys! The children really want toys to play with at playtime and lunchtime.

This led to the concept of Toy Pods. A year group pod that contains a wide range of small toys for the children to play with. Toys such as ...

Toys, games and puzzles facilitate play and encourage children to work collaboratively, they provide pleasure and the opportunity to share an interest with another child.



The introduction of Toy Pods will provide the children with higher levels of enjoyment and ensure playtimes and lunchtimes are pleasurable for everybody.

Year group Toy Pods provide the opportunity for a variety of toys, games and puzzles that are age appropriate, although there are plenty of Year 6s who will enjoy playing with cars!

We are in the process of ordering the storage, toys, games and puzzles to enable us to launch this new strategy in January. I believe it will provide an exciting start to the new year for all children.

As you can imagine to complete this project successfully, and for it to have the desired impact, we are ordering a lot of toys, games and puzzles. As mentioned, the school is purchasing all the storage and the majority of toys but some of you may be keen to contribute to this exciting project. Please can you make sure that all breaktime snacks and packed lunches are nut free / without traces of nuts.




ROAD CLOSURE
