<u>Please remember</u> that if your child or anyone in your household develops one of the three main symptoms,

- the whole household must self-isolate
- and the individual with symptoms must have a PCR test.

I am aware of how much disruption self-isolation causes but it is vital that we continue to follow this protocol. This means if a child is off school with one of the symptoms, siblings should not be attending school until a negative test result is received or the 10 day isolation period is completed.

Dease remember lateral flow tests are **not to be used to test** an individual if they have one of the three main symptoms. **Symptoms always require a PCR test and the household to self-isolate**. Lateral flow tests are for detecting the virus in asymptomatic individuals.


