Politeness	We will be well-mannered and courteous towards everyone at Amherst School.
Fairness	We will treat everyone as our equal (s) at Amherst School.
Cooperation	We will all work together to include each other as a team at Amherst School.

The Parents

We will do our best to ensure that:-

- we build a positive relationship with the school for the benefit of our child.
- our child attends regularly and arrives punctually and properly equipped. Personal items are clearly labelled with checks made at the beginning of each term.
- we encourage our child to be organised and reliably responsible for themselves and their belongings.
- we inform the school of the reasons for absence by telephone or letter BEFORE 08.50 a.m. in the morning.
- we avoid taking our child on holiday during term time.
- we support the school's values, discipline policy and rules by encouraging a positive attitude towards school.
- we encourage our child to do their best and highlight achievement.
- we provide working space and a quiet environment for homework and provide support and resources as necessary.
- we attend parents' meetings and bring any concerns promptly to the school's attention.
- our child goes to bed at a sensible time during the school week.
- we inform the school about any factors, including medical information, which might affect our child's work, welfare or behaviour.
- we encourage our child to be well mannered and to respect the feelings of others.
- we encourage our child to walk to and from school each day.

The School

We will do our best to ensure that:-

- we build a positive partnership with parents in the best interests of their children.
- children are well taught, cared for and treated fairly.
- parents are given early warning of any problems with their child's work or behaviour.
- appropriate action is taken in cases of pupils' misconduct or unauthorised absence.
- attention is paid to any parental or community concerns or complaints and action taken as deemed appropriate.
- parents are kept informed about the curriculum and teaching methods
- parents are invited to be involved in school activities.
- parents are offered regular information about their child's progress, and are invited to meet their child's teacher at Parents' Evenings. There will also be three Open Afternoons each year for children to share their work with parents. Further concerns can be dealt with by an appointment made through the School Office.
- the children are provided with a safe and secure environment and that the Health and Safety policy is reviewed regularly.
- an annual written report is sent to parents and the teacher will be available to discuss this report if parents would like to do so.
