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THE NEW SYSTEMS OF ManaGING COVID Cases IN SCHOOLS Has Taken a LITTLE GETTING USED TO THIS WEEK. It is quite a psychological shift for all of us which includes staff, parents and children. It is interesting to reflect that under the old self-isolation rules seven out of our twelve classes would now be completing remote learning at home.

The children have had so much disruption to their learning over the last two years. I am pleased that despite the cases we currently have, most children are still attending school and receiving a full curriculum.

I Have had the pleasure of visiting most classes over the Last two weeks to spend some time observing how the Children have settled on their really impressed with how quickly the new routines have been embedded. Children have demonstrated positive attitudes to their learning and behaviour. Over the last two weeks I have been part of such a wide range of lessons that have included:

Year 6

- * Character descriptions from Goodnight Mister Tom
- * Ordering decimals in maths
- * Identifying different places of worship for a range of religions

Year 5

- * Description of life in a Victorian workhouse
- * Year 5 exploration of 'Who is God' in RE

Year 4

- * Identifying the different types of teeth for herbivores, omnivores & carnivores
- * Rounding up to four digit numbers in maths
- * Identifying the features of a fable
- * Using Roman Numerals in maths
- * Understanding what happened at The Battle of Stamford Bridge in history

Year 3

- * Understanding the place value of each digit in maths
- * Character descriptions from Matilda

This is just a snapshot of the learning that is taking place every-

day across our school. The children are engaged and motivated to learn and really enjoy the diversity of the curriculum. **SWIMMING** continues to be enjoyed by all and it is great to see the pool getting so much use.
