WILL GRILL'S VISIT

Each year group **enjoyed a fantastic workshop with Will Grill** on Wednesday 10th November.

He gave a wonderful talk about how he created Bandoola and shared photos of his research trip to Myanmar. The

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children then had the opportunity to paint using ink (sorry for any stained hands or clothing!) imitating his style of art. This ranged from exploring mark making to painting elephants and teak trees.

Will spent his lunchtime signing books, although we underestimated just how many children would bring in a book! Due to the high demand, Will then generously stayed on after school to ensure every book was signed. END OF DAY ROUTINE

We have been observing and listening to feedback regarding our pick up routine at the end of the day. I would like to make a couple of small changes to routine and guidance. We will now open the metal pavement gate from 3.20pm to allow families

We will open the wooden gate at 3.30pm to enable Year 3 and 4 parents to go onto the playground to collect their child. Please could Year 5 and 6 parents wait outside the wooden gate for their child.

ROAD SAFETY

I am receiving an increasing number of communications from concerned neighbours and parents regarding road safety after school. A combination of poor parking, congestion and lack of road safety awareness is making it increasingly dangerous. How can you help?



- Try if possible to walk to school, or park a little distance away to lessen the amount of cars in the immediate area.
- If parking, be considerate to neighbours by not blocking driveways and not parking illegally, which can create dangerous pinch points forcing cars to swerve out to pass by.
- Talk to your child about how to cross a road safely if they are walking on their own. Practise crossing the road with them.
- If walking with your child, model safe crossing of the road to help be safe when they cross on their own.


