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Sir Linkalot

We were treated on Monday to a whole day visit from Sir Linkalot. In the morning he provided combined workshops for Years 3/4, Years 5/6 and a whole school assembly. The afternoon was spent working with smaller groups from each year group.

It was great for the children to meet him in person rather than just seeing him on YouTube. As you would expect, they were lively sessions with all children highly engaged by his energy and humour.

The Sir Linkalot spelling app/website is just part of our whole school spelling strategy. At the end of last year Mrs Archer and Miss Apps created a bespoke spelling progression scheme from Year 3 to Year 6. This details the spelling rules to be taught in each year group and how the Sir Linkalot words can be integrated into this. Sir Linkalot on its own is not enough to enable our children to become confident spellers. The true success measure of any spelling strategy is if the children transfer learnt spellings into their creative/ independent writing.



COVID Update

We continue to have cases at school. Today we have 9 children and 3 members of staff absent who are absent with either a positive lateral flow test or PCR test.

Unfortunately one of the members of staff is myself (confirmed PCR). I have been absent from school since Wednesday 24th November and will return on Monday 6th December. At the moment I feel the usual flu like symptoms but hopefully will start to feel better soon. I am fortunate to have such a fantastic Assistant Headteacher Miss Jones, who will lead the school superbly in my absence. We also have a strong wider senior leadership team consisting of our four year group leaders, Mrs Billing (SENCO) and Mrs Wicks (School Business Manager). I'm sure the school will operate very smoothly in my absence which may make me feel slightly redundant!

Myself and Ms Bradley (Headteacher Riverhead Infants' School) have made the joint decision that we will not mix schools regarding the attendance of siblings at Riverhead's Nativity plays and Amherst's Year 4 Christmas Variety Show.


