COVID UPDATE

Please be aware there has been a **change this week in guidance regarding daily testing and close contacts**. Please **click here** to read the full guidance.

If there is any change in guidance for schools over the Christmas holidays I will do my best to inform you as soon as possible.

Anyone aged 5 years and over, who has been identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 and who is not legally required to self-isolate, is now strongly advised to take a rapid lateral flow device (LFD) test every day for 7 days or until 10 days since their last contact with the person who tested positive for COVID-19 if this is earlier. If any of these LFD tests are positive they should self-isolate in order to protect other people.

The public health advice for people with symptoms of, or a positive test result for COVID-19 remains the same for everyone.

Once your application has been received a member of the Mega Camps team will contact you to notify you if your space has been confirmed.

On the application form it will ask you for your eligibility code. Please enter your **Wonde Voucher Code**. You should have received this code from your school. The Wonde Voucher code is evidence that you are in receipt of benefit-related free school meals and that your child is eligible for the HAF programme.

If for whatever reason your school isn't able to provide you with a Wonde Voucher Code then please use the below code instead depending on what Mega Camps location you are booking for:

Please note that these HAF spaces are limited, so please book fast to avoid disappointment.
