
Alongside our general governor visits we also have **Year Group Governor visits**. One governor is assigned to each year group who then follow that cohort through the school **to gain a strong understanding of their four year journey at Amherst**. Year Group Governors visit three times a year and spend time in each classroom, meet with children to share and discuss their work and meet with the Year Group Leader.

We are fortunate at Amherst to have such a committed group of governors who give up much of their time to support the school. Governors have the tricky task of holding the school accountable while simultaneously providing support. The role is best described as a critical friend.
