

### MESSAGE FROM MR REID



You may already be aware that the teachers' union NEU voted in favour of **strike action**. The first strike is planned for Wednesday 1st February. **The school will be open as normal** and I currently do not anticipate any disruption to classes.

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Thank you to all 157 parents that contributed to our recent parent survey. It is really useful to gain feedback, both positive and regarding areas that could be improved. Thank you to everyone that took the time to write a comment providing more detail and further information.

In all the areas the **vast majority** of you either *Strongly Agreed* or *Agreed* with the questions asked. This is helpful in **validating the good work we are doing** and **encouraging that for most of you**, your child's education at Amherst is a positive experience. I am acutely aware that each child's and parent's experience is individual and this will shape your response.

At a leadership and governor level, we have analysed the responses and looked for any trends between year groups or areas to improve.

It was also pleasing to find out that most of you **read the newsletter every week**! We are trying to **use the newsletter as the main point of communication** once a week to reduce the amount of emails you receive from school.


