MESSAGE FROM MR REID


Whole School Book Project

The artwork and storytelling through pictures is superb. David Wiesner is an American author with *Flotsam* winning the **Caldecott Medal in 2007**.

An exciting development for our book projects is that this project will be a collaboration across five local schools (Chevening, Kemsing, Sundridge and Brasted, St. Katharine's

building providing this learning experience which would not be possible in their classrooms. I don't think the children have eaten so many vegetables before! Please click here for more photos.












I hope you all have a **good half term break** and we look forward to welcoming the children back on Monday 20th February.


