Politeness

This term's value is Politeness. I used Monday's assembly to discuss and explain what politeness is and how it looks in action. For some children, developing their emotional intelligence to become more self-aware will be one of their greatest challenges.

To be polite **you have to think of other people's feelings** and how you are presenting. I shared with the children **fourteen actions** that research has shown polite people do. I asked the children to **identify three that they needed** to work on. The actions were:

- They can admit when they're wrong
- They don't touch people without permission
- They say "Please" and "Thank you"
- They don't ask overly personal questions
- They accept correction graciously
- They make others feel comfortable
- They don't interrupt
- They have polite body language
- They disagree without anger
- They don't gossip
- They don't listen to gossip either
- They listen more than they speak
- They don't take joy in others' mistakes
- They know the difference between their indoor and outdoor voice
- As adults, it is a useful list of reminders too!
