children were **working hard to interpret line graphs** and showed good understanding. I was part of an interesting class discussion working out how to calculate the formula for speed = distance ÷ time. distance = speed × time. GCSE maths!

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The children were keen to share their **compost project** and some **wonderful art creations** linked to the *Flotsam* project. I can't wait to see the finished displays which have started to appear this week around the hall.
