
Inter House Sport



Donate your child's outgrown shoes that still have plenty of wear left in them so that they can find their next pair of feet.

Throughout the Summer Term, Amherst School Council wish to support this worthwhile charity, which collects, sorts and redistributes all types of children's outgrown shoes in the UK and abroad. The donated shoes do not have to be school shoes but must be children's shoes (no heels). Each pair of shoes MUST be:

- outgrown NOT outworn,
- clean, without holes & good laces if needed
- in a pair with an elastic band around it
- optional, a note for the new owner of your shoes

Collection

There will be a box in every classroom throughout the Summer Term where your child can drop off their outgrown shoes. School Council will then help sort, label and package them throughout the term. Miss Jones will take the shoes to SALS Shoes HQ in Edenbridge at the end of the term.

Each pair of shoes donated to school requires a minimum donation of £1 to help them on their way to the next owner. Therefore, we are holding a SALS Shoes cake sale after school on Friday 23rd June to fundraise towards the cost of sending our shoes away. new school shoes until September. Therefore, any school shoes must be donated the last week of school term 17th-21st July and the school will make an allowance for wearing trainers that week only.




