The children were inspired by his determination to end apartheid and the struggles that he endured. I used the excellent book by Chris Van Wyk which tells Nelson Mandela's story in a child friendly way.

The children were amazed how a little boy could grow up to fight apartheid, spend 27 years in prison and then **become South** Africa's first black president and campaign for freedom and justice throughout the world.

We ended Tuesday's assembly by watching the original footage of Mr Mandela's release and then learnt more about his positive impact on the world before his death aged 95 in 2013.




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Screen Time


