MESSAGE FROM MR REID

Dare to be You

An excellent book that I have referenced in previous newsletters over the years is *Dare to be You* by Matthew Syed. It is a wonderful child friendly book that provides **strategies to help children be themselves**. The purpose of the books is as follows:

What if you stopped worrying about fitting in? I'm going to let you into a secret. Are you ready? There's no such thing as 'normal'. So if you're the kind of person who thinks...

- *I hate standing out from the crowd*
- *I wish I could be more like the cool kids*
- *It's pointless trying to change things*

... then this book is going to blow your mind. I'm here to dare you to follow your own path, to love what makes you different and to question the world around you. Because if you believe in yourself, you can be your very own action hero. So what are you waiting for? Dare to be you.

Matthew Syed describes what he calls *The Plan* which lists **eight actions to enable you to be yourself**.


1. Make friends with people who like you for you.
2. Make choices based on what you feel is right.
3. Don't blindly copy other people. Be You.
4. Ask questions. Keep asking questions. Make things work for you.
5. Don't be afraid to do things at your own pace.
6. You should be prepared to be flexible.
7. Be kind. And don't listen to anyone who isn't kind towards you.
8. Make it happen. Don't wait. Get out there. It is down to you.


